Main Draw Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) Area

Open November 1 — April 9

The Main Draw OHV area is the only place on the Pawnee National Grassland where OHVs are permitted.

OHVs must be registered with Colorado State Parks. Visit http://parks.state.co.us

The current registration fee is **\$25.25** for resident and non-resident OHV permits. Registration decals must be affixed permanently on the upper forward half of the OHV, where the decal can be easily seen.

Park, unload and load OHVs only in the designated parking area.

A U.S. Forest Service approved spark arrester is required for use on any public lands.

OHVs must not exceed 50" in width.

OHVs are allowed only in the draw (gulley, ravine, arroyo). **Do not ride on roads or across the prairie.**

If you see an individual riding out of season or in an undesignated area, get a license plate number of the haul vehicle and a description of the bike/rider and contact the Pawnee National Grassland District office at **(970) 346-5000**.

Travel by licensed (street legal) motorized vehicles is permitted only on county roads and on numbered routes designated for travel on the Pawnee National Grassland Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM).

Free MVUMs are available at the Pawnee National Grassland District office. **(970) 346-5000**

Respect the rights of private landowners.

Leave gates as you find them.

Pack it in; pack it out.
